Accession and claim statistics and other reports allow analysis of bibliographic data and publisher activity, for collection development, etc.

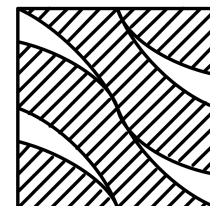
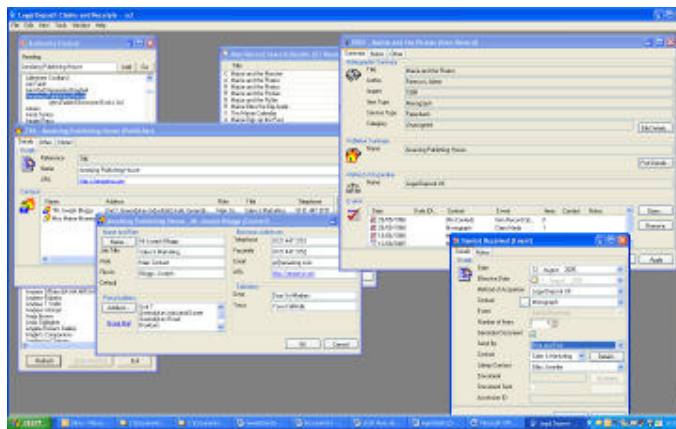
Support for migration from existing legacy systems, preserving, and where possible cleaning, existing data.
